#### Interactive Read-Alouds


We will listen to and discuss the following books: Text Set: Learning and Working Together: School


Essential Question: What makes a school feel like a community?

by Stephanie Stuve-Bodeen & Jamaica's Blue Marker by Juanita Havill












#### Shared Reading
