**Texts:** First Day Jitters by Julie Danneburg & A Fine, Fine School by Sharon Creech






#### **Shared Reading**

#### Readers' & Writers' Workshops

We will learn the following classroom principles that support independent reading and writing work:

- Use an appropriate voice level
- Move from one spot to another quickly and quietly
- Turn and talk to share your thinking
- Listen carefully to each other
- Find ways to solve problems when you need help
- Do your best work

#### MATH

We will complete the Grade 1 Readiness Quiz and begin the first topic of first grade.

**Topic 1: Understand Addition and Subtraction**This topic develops a deeper understanding of addition and subtraction by working on "add to", "put together", "take from", "take apart" and "compare" problems.

#### SCIENCE

We begin our first unit: Waves: light and sound with a hands-on experiment with vibrating tunning forks!
