RESIDENCY AFFIDAVIT

Pursuant to Education Law 3202(1), school districts are only obligated to provide tuition-free education to students whose parents or legal guardians reside within the district. Residence is established by one's physical presence as an inhabitant within the district and the intent to reside in the school district. A person can have only one legal residence. Mere ownership or renting of property in the district is insufficient to establish residency. In order to establish residency, a person must abandon his or her former residence and establish a new residence. A child's residence is presumed to be that of his or her parents or legal guardians. This Affidavit is for the purpose of the Quogue Union Free School District determining whether a child is a legal resident of the School District. In the event you suspect that your child may be entitled to attend the School District based upon his or her status as homeless, please contact the School District for further information.

I / We understand that the District may investigate any allegation contained in this form and may ask for written proof of any statement. I / We agree to fully cooperate with any investigation by the District of the facts set forth or related to this Affidavit and to provide any requested information.

I / We understand that in the event the information contained in this Affidavit is determined to be inaccurate or false, in whole or in part, the above-named child will be withdrawn from the District and the District may commence legal proceedings against me personally to collect the costs of educating such child and / or seek criminal action against me for fraud, falsifying business records and / or filing a false document.
